That's a pretty serious song, you can't really sing that song anywhere, to be bonded together with people who are not dedicated. I always felt guilty singing it with that group because I knew that they were not committed. It was just a game. So why would you want to be bonded together with them. You have to be really dedicated, tested and tried. There are some people that you just don't want to be bound together with, looking back with the direction that some of them went, this guy comes along with a different view and so on. So you have to be careful with who you want to be bonded together with. There are a lot of people that were brought up in this truth, and for a lot, it is just a game, they did not come through this tough channel as we did. We can really sing that song, and worship in spirit and in truth and mean it. Like it says here: *You are the family of God*. You can't say that to just anyone, because people have not made that commitment, they have other priorities. I like that song, it is a dream that I had, that is the way it should be. The Lord can't bind you together with someone that doesn't believe right, even

with Randy, he has all kinds of different views, he is not dedicated, and not willing to get rid of them either. Just wallowing in that ideology in his head. He is 40 years old so hopefully, he is teachable, being 40 years old already and not having accumulated nothing spiritual that's quite something. When I was that age I just was so consumed with this Word, spent time in the Word, dedicated to the Lord, feasting on that Manna from above. It is a wasted life, not having accumulated anything for eternity.

We have it good, and the reason we have it good is because we have made certain decisions. We can truly sing that song: *Bind us together*. I knew that that was the way it should be if God does not bind this together it is not going to work, but how can He bind it together with people that have so many different views. It is all such a mess, God sees the heart, and sometimes I could see some of their hearts. I don't want to be bonded together with people that go contrary to the Word of God. They will stab you in the back just to build themselves an empire. Here we don't have that baggage, and God is going to bring people in that are genuine. This is just a start, and we are going to detect them.

This is His program, He lets me know that this is His program, so all we need to do is on a day to day basis walk with Him. We can sing these songs and worship in spirit and in truth. It is not this whole

masses of people that the Lord is looking at, who go to church just to appease their neighbour, or just because it is a thing to do. Yes, it is better to go to church than to a bar as far as that goes, and somewhere along the way a person might pick up something.

It is like going to school and somewhere along the way you have to go out in the work force with what you have been taught. That is what I have been seeing, the ministry of brother Jackson and brother Branham and then the five-fold ministry is there until the point where you have learned what you need and then you have to go out and apply what you have learned. I took every opportunity to go to convention and as long as brother Jackson was here the preaching was good, but there came a day when that era was over.

Like when we were given that piece of paper to write that exam, what is the point in going back to school when you have your diploma, you are graduated and you don't go back to school, maybe to do some upgrading every so often. In the real world, once you get your graduation certificate, you go find a job and apply what you have learned while you were in school. That is where you and I are at, we went through school and we have learned the message for our day and we have remembered the things that we have been taught. You have to go back, and go over things, to see if you are still in the faith. Now we are in service for the Lord, and the work that He has given us is this internet and

these books. That's our job, We don't go back to listen to Fred, because he doesn't have anything to say, it is confusion.

I was thinking about that during the week with the scripture the Lord gave you — remember the things that you have been taught and remember who you have been taught them from. Paul told that to Timothy. When you really go into it Paul received these things from that angel. Here in our hour; we have been taught these things from that angel. That angel used brother Branham's, and brother Jackson's vocal cords. Now that they are gone that verse comes into effect — to remember the things that you have been taught. Now, these seducing spirits are out there trying to seduce with these false teachings that are being taught now by these preachers.

This is not my thought, we are still on that same topic that we were on last week. If the Lord does not give you something new, He usually wants me to go over the conversation again. It is a good message, but there are things in there that don't really pertain to this topic, and we need to keep it in its simplicity, just because you and I see it there are a lot of people out there that do not realize that this is what they are looking for. You have to keep it simple so people can understand it. I want to go about it from a different angle.

First of all, you have to know who Paul was, Paul was the apostle to the gentiles. He was not some fly-by-night. You have to take what Paul said very seriously, just like when Jesus was here. You need to take the Word of God very serious, and if you don't you can easily fall into the idea that Paul hated women and he didn't know what he was talking about in Corinthians. Paul cared for people and one time he said in Romans that he wished himself to be condemned for the sake of the Jews. Like Mose he wanted God to write him out of His book, only save these people, that was the heart of Moses. That was the heart of Paul too. He cared about people.

I want to go over 1 Corinthians 7. I want to read it in the NIV it really comes out in that translation.

1. Now for the matters you wrote about: "It is good for a man not to have sexual relations with a woman."

2. But since sexual immorality is occurring, each man should have sexual relations with his own wife, and each woman with her own husband.

Paul is going over marriage because he knows that there is something that is better than marriage. We are living at the end-time, there are only a couple more years left of the Grace Age. When you listen to people who are talk show host, they don't talk like we talk, we know the hour we are living in. Not one of these preachers out there will let people know, they will talk about the end time but nothing definite, it has no

substance. It does not come through that they know the hour that we are living in, they will mention it but they have no scriptural facts to make it clear for people that we are truly living in the end-time.

We talked on it last week how sex for pleasure was introduced by the serpent in the garden. Sex was only meant for reproduction purposes, which was the tree of life. In order to be fruitful and multiply you have to have an intimate relationship. The tree of knowledge of good and evil was sex for pleasure. Had Adam and Eve stayed with the tree of life law there would be no problems in this world. We know that man has been on earth for 6000 years and the Grace Age is coming to an end it is all going back to that perfect environment that God had when He put Adam and Eve in the garden. In 1 Corinthians 7, Paul is bringing it out that it is good not to have sexual relations with a woman, married or single it does not matter, but because of immorality was occurring each man should have relations with his own wife, and each woman with her own husband. It still comes out that it is better not to have sexual relationship. This sex is really a delusion, God never meant sex being used for pleasure, He meant it for reproduction purposes only.

I was married for 15 years until that Hutterite system terminated me because there came a day when I could no longer support it. I saw it for what it was. When I read my Bible I saw that it is not compatible

with the Bible. I told my dad that I can no longer support him and that system. J. K said, he can break any man all he has to do is take his sex away from him and that is what they did. At the end of the day, you are either going to break or go on in the Lord. That is why I can say today - Sex for pleasure was introduced by Satan through that serpent creature and it has no eternal value. It is a delusion and something that the devil uses to lure people down the path to destruction. That is how he got Eve in the garden. The devil uses it for a lure, like when you go out fishing you put some bait on to catch a fish, that is what sex for pleasure is, it is a trap and a delusion.

That's why I say when Paul said something you have to take it very seriously. To a lot of people, they just think that he was an old cranky guy, but I take what Paul said very seriously. Just look at the tremendous revelation that he had. Look at the concern that he had for his own people, that he would rather have himself condemned, just to save his own people. That is the heart of Paul, so when you see a man who has that kind of a heart you have to take what he said seriously. What it really points down to, is falling in love with that Word, because it is for our benefit. Paul was revealed and he said: *"It is good for a man not to have sexual relations with a woman."*

You and I know what this sex thing is all about, and where it all originated from. Sex for pleasure originated

back in the garden. Like I said before - If you take sex for pleasure out of the equation then there are really no problems because that is where all this chaos originated from. Paul goes on to talk about married couples but that is not our issue here that we want to go over. I want to continue on to verse 6:

6. I say this as a concession, not as a command.

*7. **I wish that all of you were as I am.** But each of you has your own gift from God; one has this gift, another has that.*

You have to understand Paul, he was trying, as he says towards the end of the chapter - I spare you. He meant it to save people from a lot of heartaches, from a lot of pain, and a lot of suffering. This conversation that we are having would not have worked 20-30 years ago, because it was still needful to be fruitful and to multiply. That is the commission God gave to Adam and Eve in the garden, but we are now living some short years before the coming of the Lord. Paul was saying those that marry as if they did not marry. It is not a priority anymore to get married and to have children. We know how short time is.

If you listen to these evangelical preachers and these talk show hosts they will not tell you how short time is; that we are almost at the end of the grace age, but you and I we know where we are in time.

Jesus talked about how it was in the days of Noah and in the days of Lot, so will it be when the Son of man will come. When you really sit back and analyze it, people do not know the hour that they are living in, they think everything is going well we have nothing to worry about. That's what they thought in Noah's day. They didn't know that there will be a flood. They heard it from Noah but they mocked him. One day the flood came and it took them all away. When Jesus wept over Jerusalem in *Luke 19*, because they didn't know the time of their visitation, they had to suffer and be dispersed throughout the world for nearly 2,000 years.

41. And when he was come near, he beheld the city, and wept over it,

42. Saying, If thou hadst known, even thou, at least in this thy day, the things which belong unto thy peace! but now they are hid from thine eyes.

43. For the days shall come upon thee, that thine enemies shall cast a trench about thee, and compass thee round, and keep thee in on every side,

44. And shall lay thee even with the ground, and thy children within thee; and they shall not leave in thee one stone upon another; because thou knewest not the time of thy visitation.

Today in this hour it is the same thing, people they do not know, sure people have been talking about it for many years now, but you can tell it by their actions and by the business world, they are completely clueless

that there are only 2-3 years left for the Grace Age, then everything is going to go helter-skelter. Then the 7 years that are left to the Jews will start.

We know this, so we can have this conversation, that where we are in a time now it is better to be single. You made the best decision that any girl could make in the hour that we are now living it. There are millions of girls out there they would do the same thing if they only knew the benefits. That marriage thing and that sex thing it is full of heartaches and pain and sorrow. You don't need to go down that path; you can bypass all that, and you are prove of all that. We are not just having this conversation, we are living examples.

When I got terminated from the Hutterite system, when my last daughter was born I knew that that was it as far as sex goes for me. I knew it in my heart. When I look back now, I can see it clearly, the Lord was saying, that is it, I have a different program for you now. He led me through these different systems through these denominational churches, and brought me to the ministry of brother Branham and then to the ministry of brother Jackson. When I look back and I take inventory, that is why we are where we are today, I was guided by that unseen hand. I was guided by that Word. *-Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path.*

When you sit back and analyze it there are no two people that have it better than you and me. We don't have that much but we have more than enough. We

have it so good, and I'm just overwhelmed with gratitude how good we have it. We have no issues, no problems. Simply because we decided to follow Jesus; and simply because you decided one day you don't want to go down that marriage road. I didn't even know you existed. It is not something I brainwashed you into, I didn't twist your arm about it. I always thought that that was the way it should be, it is a voluntary thing when the Lord took me off the colony, He allowed me to see somethings. In order for someone to leave that colony, you have to leave all that stuff behind, your furniture and all that stuff, but it is a voluntary thing. You can't twist someone's arm and say — you have to do this, or that.

My dad, he tried to do a lot of things that we are actually doing now, he didn't believe in that Christmas thing, one year he passed a law that there would be no Christmas presents given that year. He had the same idea. One day he said we should burn all our furniture, he was picking up something, what it was he was picking up the real thing that God had for mankind and that was we don't need all this furniture. What he was picking up was for people to put their priorities in place get ready for the coming of the Lord, instead of materialism. It would be crazy for hundreds of people to go out and burn their furniture. It would be kind of cultic, it is an individual thing. I never told you to leave your furniture on the colony, but I knew if you want to go on

in the Lord, I figured that is what a person would have to do, not to have no contamination with that colony thing at all. It belongs to the Catholic church; to the Vatican through that water baptism. At the end of the day that is who is going to get it. If you voluntarily walk away from that without legislating anything, if you legislate it then it becomes cultic, but if you voluntarily leave that stuff behind that's a different story then. You did that voluntarily and eventually as things progressed the Lord brought us together because I had the same desire. I did not want that junk. They wanted to give me something from my dad's, I didn't want anything. I don't even want to drink their water, completely nothing, because that is the way that I felt it should be, but you can't legislate it.

Here a few years back I thought that we should legislate fasting when brother Boyd was at the helm, I thought instead of when going to convention and having these meals, we should fast for 40 days and have conventions and no meals, to be tuned into just to spiritual things, but when you start legislating things then it becomes cultic, and control factors.

We are supposed to be led by the spirit, and here you were led by the spirit to follow Jesus, you don't want to go down that marriage path. When you look back at how God brought this thing together. Before that I didn't know you existed, but back then when you said that and made that decision, in fact before the

foundation of the world, God knew that you were going to make the right decision. So you made the decision that you don't want to go down that marriage path, that you want to live for Jesus. Then with time, God brought us together.

Paul had the same desire for people. He said: *I wish that all of you were as I am, (that is male and female). But each of you has your own gift from God; one has this gift, another has that.*

Like I have said, Paul was not some fly by night, he had a concern for the human race at heart, he was that apostle to the gentiles. He had a lot of people under his watch that he cared for, and he was concerned about their spiritual well-being. He said it over and over again that it is best that you remain as I am, and he was referring to being single. Never mind this sex thing. He can't forbid it, that would be taking away free choice, he is just suggesting it. That is what we are doing we are not forbidding it, we know the hour and time that we are living in and for this hour it is best to remain single. You made the right choice.

8. Now to the unmarried and the widows I say: It is good for them to stay unmarried, as I do.

9. But if they cannot control themselves, they should marry, for it is better to marry than to burn with passion.

For myself, I have to say that I wish that everything would be as easy to over come as that sex thing. If a

person is not fasting and is always indulging in the flesh it might be a problem but where I am at right now. It is the easiest thing to overcome. It is not even a blip on my radar. It is not even on my radar. The carnal man cannot understand that, because that is part of the carnal man's makeup. That is all they think when they see us together. It is hard for them to comprehend. I wish food would be as easy to overcome as sex. At the end of the day, sex is a lot of work and there is nothing in it, it is a delusion.

It is lust and the Bible talks about it. There are thousands and thousands of people that would want this if they could only break away from this sex thing. It says in *James 1*:

12. Blessed is the man that endureth temptation: for when he is tried, he shall receive the crown of life, which the Lord hath promised to them that love him.

13. Let no man say when he is tempted, I am tempted of God: for God cannot be tempted with evil, neither tempteth he any man:

14. But every man is tempted, when he is drawn away of his own lust, and enticed.

15. Then when lust hath conceived, it bringeth forth sin: and sin, when it is finished, bringeth forth death.

It says, blessed is the man that endureth temptation, you put those things aside because at the end of that temptation is hell. If you give in to those lusts it brings forth sin, and sin brings death.

When you make that decision to follow the Lord and not go the marriage way you save yourself a lot of sorrow and a lot of pain.

I want to continue reading from 1 Corinthians 7:

10. To the married I give this command (not I, but the Lord): A wife must not separate from her husband.

11. But if she does, she must remain unmarried or else be reconciled to her husband. And a husband must not divorce his wife.

I don't want to go into that part I want to stay focused on what Paul said regarding remaining single. My opinion of Paul's situation was similar to my situation, I never knew that that was going to happen, that I will be terminated from the colony and separated from my wife, it was not on my radar, but that religious system like I said last week, I believe when Paul became a Christian they took his wife away from him because he was brought up in that Sanhedrin council, very religious Jews and when he became converted to Christianity, those two things did not mix. I believe that he had to leave his wife behind, because he had to have a wife, and be a married man to be on the Sanhedrin council. Just like on the Hutterite Colony in order to become a preacher you have to be a married man, the same here with Paul he was married at one time because he could not sit on the Sanhedrin council without being a married man. Maybe she died I do not know, but whatever happened to her he never bothered

to get married again, because he stressed that he would that people would be as he was, and he was a single man. He was advising everyone else to stay single.

I was going to say this that I do not believe in divorce. In my situation, I had no choice but to separate. For me to go back on the colony, knowing what I know, I would have to deny the Lord, and practically say to the Lord - go fly a kite, I am going back to the colony, back to my wife. You see I cannot go and deny the Lord, for that to be I would have to lose my eternal salvation, to compromise with that system, which I know is a cult. I decide what I am going to do and that is to follow the Lord. There is no give and take here, I could but then I would lose my salvation. I am going to continue down this road, it is a good road. Like Paul wrote it down in this epistle, I do not believe in remarrying and I do not believe in divorce. If you need to separate, then separate, but once you are separated or divorced I do not believe in getting married again, not in any circumstances. If you really burn and have a passion for this sex thing, then go back and be reconciled and do whatever it takes. If this sex thing is more important then your relationship with the Lord, then I would go back to the colony and be reconciled with my wife, that is my situation, but this is more important to me, this is eternal, this is a glorious journey that we are on. We are not interested in this

sex. It is just something that you have to establish in your heart, that it is off limits.

Like I said before when my youngest daughter was born, it was like the Lord was saying - I am taking you on this journey and you might as well forget about this sex. It has been a glorious journey. That is my opinion about divorce. I know a lot of people they divorce and remarry, even as Christians but for me, I could never do that. People can go and read that chapter what pertains to them, for us the advice to the married that Paul is talking about, that does not pertain to us.

17. Nevertheless, each person should live as a believer in whatever situation the Lord has assigned to them, just as God has called them.

Once I was terminated from that colony, the Lord has assigned me a different work. He has assigned me this single life. That is my calling in life, this marriage and sex thing is not part of it, it is not on my radar. Sure if you indulge in the flesh then eventually you would be dragged back into the muck and the mire. Into all kinds of stuff that is out there, but you have to be led by the spirit and you will not fulfill the lust of the flesh. You can determine that you are going to walk in the spirit, that I will dedicate myself to the Lord. I will spend my time in prayer and fasting. That is the journey that you and I are on.

This is the rule I lay down in all the churches. Was a man already circumcised when he was called? He should not become uncircumcised.

18. Was a man uncircumcised when he was called? He should not be circumcised.

19. Circumcision is nothing and uncircumcision is nothing.

Today circumcision is not something that people debate but back in the early church it was something that people were confused about, and they needed some clarification on it. It was a transition for the old testament into the new testament. It was something that people were struggling with.

Keeping God's commands is what counts.

20. Each person should remain in the situation they were in when God called them.

21. Were you a slave when you were called? Don't let it trouble you—although if you can gain your freedom, do so.

We were called out of that system out of that slave thing, out of that cage. We are out of it, and don't even have a desire to go back into it not even to visit. We are free of it, of course, we care about the people, and you do everything that you can. Like Paul he had a heart for his people, we will always have that desire and a heart for people to get saved. It is something that you can't take out. I don't have to go back and live there.

22. For the one who was a slave when called to faith in the Lord is the Lord's freed person; similarly, the one who was free when called is Christ's slave.

23. You were bought at a price; do not become slaves of human beings.

24. Brothers and sisters, each person, as responsible to God, should remain in the situation they were in when God called them.

25. Now about virgins: I have no command from the Lord, but I give a judgment as one who by the Lord's mercy is trustworthy.

Here Paul is saying that he did not receive this as a commandment from the Lord, but you can see Paul's concern. He was wanting to spare people the trouble and he wanted to give them some advice on how to do it. He wanted to show and help people how to make it through life in a very successful way with no hard-aches and no sorrows. He wanted to make it easy on people, and that is really our desire here to do.

26. Because of the present crisis, I think that it is good for a man to remain as he is.

Here he is stating why he believes it is better for people to remain single and he mentions the present crisis. What he is saying because of the shortness of time in living at the end time before the coming of the Lord. That is the revelation that he had back there. That's what he meant because of the present crisis.

27. Are you pledged to a woman? Do not seek to be released.

28. Are you free from such a commitment? Do not look for a wife.

That is my position I am not seeking a divorce. That is the advice Paul is giving me not to seek divorce and not to get married. That is not even on my radar. *But if you do marry, you have not sinned; and if a virgin marries, she has not sinned.*

29. But those who marry will face many troubles in this life, and I want to spare you this.

That is why I am saying that you have to take Paul's advise serious because Paul had a concern for people. How many people out there today can you find that have that concern that Paul had for people. Today there is a spirit out there where people just want to use people. Like it says in the scripture, in the end-times, they will make merchandise out of you. They want your money, and they want to use people to build themselves a dynasty. Paul did not want that he had a genuine concern for people. So you can take his advise and know that he means it well.

30. What I mean, brothers and sisters, is that the time is short. From now on those who have wives should live as if they do not;

The church of the living God is built upon revelation. God determines what He will reveal to Paul at that time, and He revealed to Paul - Ephesians one.

He also revealed to Paul the seriousness of the end time and Paul thought that they are living in the end-time that there would only be a few more short years left and that would be the end of it. Paul was given that revelation and he took it seriously. It's like when you go down a road you can only see as far as your eyes can look, and when you walk further things become more focused. God revealed to Paul the conditions of living in the end-time, he actually saw where we are living now. That is all God allowed him to see, because God wanted it to be written for our hour.

31. Those who mourn, as if they did not; those who are happy, as if they were not; those who buy something, as if it were not theirs to keep; those who use the things of the world, as if not engrossed in them. For this world in its present form is passing away.

32. I would like you to be free from concern. An unmarried man is concerned about the Lord's affairs — how he can please the Lord.

That's where you fall into, you are concerned about the things of the Lord, when you look back upon your life and the pressure on a girl, on the colony, even off the colony, for a girl to get married. It is just a trick of Satan to keep you away from this glorious journey that you are on.

33. But a married man is concerned about the affairs of this world—how he can please his wife—

34. And his interests are divided. An unmarried woman or virgin is concerned about the Lord's affairs: Her aim is to be devoted to the Lord in both body and spirit. But a married woman is concerned about the affairs of this world—how she can please her husband.

35. I am saying this for your own good, not to restrict you, but that you may live in a right way in undivided devotion to the Lord.

What you and I are on is an eternal journey, it is an eternal destiny, it is the most glorious thing that a person can have. There are millions of people that would want that, but it is first things first. It is just something that you have to establish in your heart that you want to serve the Lord Jesus Christ, and God will test you. You know for yourself that you were tested with this guy and that guy coming and knocking on your door. These are all tests. Yes, you made that initial decision, that you want to stay single and live for the Lord, (you want to follow Jesus), but is Jesus going to take you at face value, He is going to put you through the grinder to test you to see if you are serious or if it just words, or if you really meant it and sometimes it even looks like the Lord wants you to get married, it will appear to be that way, but it is a test.

When you sit back and analyze it, even for myself I know when He tested me I had to really step in and with a determination say to myself - I am not going

back to no colony, if I had 10 heads and they would all have to be chopped off, all 10 would have to go.

When you read the Bible then after a while you get to know God and you get to fall in love with that Word. When you go back to the days of Ruth and her mother-in-law Naomi told her two daughter-in-law that she is going back to Israel, that it is best if you go back to your people. Ruth, she was determined to go with Naomi, it was almost as if Naomi was pushing her to go back, but she wanted her to come with her. That is how the Lord does it, He sometimes He puts something out there hoping that you will make the right choice. The Lord is not going to force you to make the right choice he will put it out there to see what you are going to do. Ruth, she was determined and said she is not going back - I go where you go, your people are my people your God is my God, and where you die, I will die. That is how determined you have to be. When the Lord was testing you, you had to be so determined that you don't want anything about that lifestyle, and then once God sees that He moves you on, but first He will test you. That is why you and I are where we are at today. We are on the most glorious journey, that you cannot even describe how glorious this journey is. We have no cares, of course, I think about my family but the Lord will look after my family somehow as long as I continue walking on with Him. Maybe not the way that I would like, I would like for all my family to be in this circle and

I tried very hard with my daughters. I wanted them to walk away from this marriage thing voluntarily, I suggested it. I let them know that they could come along with me and I would take care of you, that there is something far better than this marriage, and that is this intimacy with the Lord Jesus Christ. I did not twist their arm it has to be a voluntary thing. Eventually, they decided that they want to get married,

36. If anyone is worried that he might not be acting honorably toward the virgin he is engaged to, and if his passions are too strong and he feels he ought to marry, he should do as he wants. He is not sinning. They should get married.

37. But the man who has settled the matter in his own mind, who is under no compulsion but has control over his own will, and who has made up his mind not to marry the virgin—this man also does the right thing.

38. So then, he who marries the virgin does right, but he who does not marry her does better.

Here Paul is saying that he who marries does right but he who does not marry does better and we want the better part. It is ok to get married, but the one who does not get married does better. Why wouldn't anyone want that something better?

39. A woman is bound to her husband as long as he lives. But if her husband dies, she is free to marry anyone she wishes, but he must belong to the Lord.

40. In my judgment, she is happier if she stays as she is—and I think that I too have the Spirit of God.

I would say for single girls, they should read this passage over and over until it grabs them, because if you just read it once it does not become part of you, once it becomes part of you, you have a respect for what Paul was trying to spare them from. Paul wanted to spare people some hard-ache by this. There is something better than marriage and Paul tapped into it. This intimacy with the Lord Jesus Christ far exceeds it all.

First, it will be hard, you have to fight against the tide of society. People are always after you if you are married yet and if you found a husband yet. There is always this pressure, but once you are determined that that is what you are going to do then it becomes easier. Those that are married they think they are superior to you but really it is the other way around.

I want to go to Genesis 3 when Adam and Eve were created and put on this planet everything was good, but see you have to see this planet earth as a laboratory. It is God's laboratory, it is God's testing station — to see who is going to be found worthy to go into that eternal abode, because it is going to be a glorious thing. He tested the angels, we have been over that. Now God is going to test man. He is going to test Adam and Eve to see if they are going to pass

that test and put their trust in that Word. If they are going to be found worthy to go into that eternal habitation. We all have to be tested to see if we will be found worthy. So this planet is a laboratory if people would only see that. Sometimes you will see this question: Why are we here on this earth. We are here to be tested this is God's laboratory. To see if you are going to trust the Lord, and live holy and upright before Him in love. That is why He created us: That we should live holy before Him in love as it says in Ephesians 1:4. That is why we are down here — to be tested. Adam and Eve had to be tested.

In order to be tested there has to be something to test you with. God told them to be fruitful and to multiply but in that multiplication process there are two laws it is very simple for you and me to see, but for people who have been brainwashed to think different, it is pretty hard to convince them. I want to make it simple here for people to understand it. There was only one commission given to them - *God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth.* Adam was put in charge of this planet, and in charge of the animal kingdom. In that God tested man with the two laws to be fruitful and multiply with: one is the tree of life and God told them not to partake of the tree of

knowledge of good and evil. *And the Lord God commanded the man, saying, Of every tree of the garden thou mayest freely eat: But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die.* They knew exactly what that law was, they were in the spirit when God commissioned them to be fruitful and multiply and to replenish the earth, they were not left in the dark with it, God commanded man not to eat of the tree of knowledge of good and evil. That tree of knowledge of good and evil is sex for pleasure. You can read it in Genesis 3, how the devil used that serpent to deceive Eve.

Satan is still around today, God lets him, that's how man is tested in making a choice between what is right and wrong. Just like Ruth was being tested when Naomi told her to go back to her people, but she was determined that she is not going back no matter what. When that serpent came to Eve she should have stuck with that Word, not to partake of the tree of knowledge of good and evil to stay with that tree of life no matter what. She was seduced, that serpent kept working on her and working on her. Ruth could have been seduced too to go back, the other daughter-in-law went back, but Ruth she was determined she is not going back. Here Eve should have been determined that in no way would she partake of the tree of knowledge of good and evil - Get out of here you

serpent, I'm going to stick with the tree of life. It takes a determination. When I look back at the times that I was being tested and it took a gut-wrenching determination. Then it was like the Lord was saying — ok I get you, let's go.

As I said, they were being tested and they made the wrong choice, instead of choosing reproduction purposes only through the tree of life, they took and introduced into the human race, sex for pleasure. That is what this whole Genesis thing is about.

I want to bring out something here where the Lord comes to Adam and Eve after they partook of the tree of knowledge of good and evil.

13. Then the Lord God said to the woman, "What is this that you have done?" The woman said, "The serpent deceived me, and I ate." Genesis 3

That's what happened back in beginning, Adam and Eve partook of the wrong law for reproduction.

14. And the Lord God said unto the serpent, Because thou hast done this, thou art cursed above all cattle, and above every beast of the field; upon thy belly shalt thou go, and dust shalt thou eat all the days of thy life:

15. And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel.

When you see a serpent today all you can see is a reptile; when you talk to anyone about a serpent they

see a retiler, but see for the sake of understanding this better I'm going to give this serpent the name 'George', never mind this serpent name, because it is automatic if you think about a serpent your thoughts automatically go to a crawling reptile, but he was not a reptile when God created him. So let's say the Lord God said to 'George', instead of the name serpent, just to get the picture in your mind that he was not a serpent reptile creature in the beginning, he was an upright creature that God created to be a servant to the Human race. He was the highest form of the animal kingdom the most subtle. He had hands he could reach out for a pear and he was Adam's servant. He worked the ground and did the laborious work, and he gladly did it because that is what he was created to do. When Adam and Eve wanted something he would go and get it and he got it for them. The whole animal kingdom was put there to replenish the earth and as a help. Like horses, they were there to help mankind with. That is what the whole animal kingdom was for, to serve Adam and Eve. Adam and Eve had dominion over it all, but they failed that test, they sold out and give the planet back to Satan. It was between God and Satan and Satan stole it back by deception. It was given to Adam and Eve but they yielded to that serpent who was instrumental and inspired by Satan to do what he did.

Now when Eve was deceived by 'George,' that creature left an off spring, Cain was conceived. *I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed.* Inside of Eve was that serpent's off-spring which was Cain he was that serpents seed which God had created to serve the Human family, he was part of the animal kingdom, that Neanderthal man; he was an upright creature until God cursed him to crawling on his belly.

This is the part that I want to get to here:

16. Unto the woman he said, I will greatly multiply thy sorrow and thy conception; in sorrow thou shalt bring forth children; and thy desire shall be to thy husband, and he shall rule over thee.

Now if you read it, it says that God will greatly multiply thy sorrow and thy conception. We know that to multiply conception means that God will multiply the cycle where a woman can get pregnant. I do not know what it was before but it was more than every 28 days because it says — greatly multiply. Let's say that it was maybe once every 7 years. In the animal kingdom, they don't have an every twenty-eight day conception cycle. After the curse Eve's cycle of conception was changed to every 28 days. Like with a deer it is once a year and with a pig, I believe it is every 3 months, with an elephant it is a lot longer. They all have their cycles. The Human race had a cycle too but because they partook of the tree of knowledge of good and evil, God

multiplied conception and sorrow and it was multiplied to a 28 day cycle. God multiplied sorrow, and that is what I want to bring out here, why would you want sorrow in your life and then it says: and thy desire shall be to thy husband, and he shall rule over thee. Now, why would you want someone to rule over you when you don't even know what that guy is like. Why would you not want the Lord Jesus Christ instead. Like you and I we are not subject to nothing and nobody, we are subject to the Lord Jesus Christ as long as we stay within the confines of this Word.

That is the best choice a person can make, Paul said over and over, 'it is better to be as I am' and 'I spare you'. That is what this conversation is about to try to get you through this journey of life without the heartache. Can you think of anything better. Life could not be better and at the end of the day, you have eternal life, simply because back there you made a decision that you don't want that marriage thing, that you want to live for the Lord. Somewhere in your heart that is what you determined that you were going to do. When all these guys came along God was testing you to see if you really meant what you said, and you decided that you don't want any part of that.

I did the same thing once I spoke up against that corrupt system in the colony. I did not know where all this would lead to, I thought that I would be terminated for a month or two, and those preachers would come

to their senses. I didn't know what I know now, you can't convert these preachers, they have to step back and they have to do that themselves. Don't think that you can change that whole Hutterite system, because — 'der satan ist der herr darin'. It is controlled by that catholic spirit. People will say that that is pretty rough, but you have to be truthful, they have that false baptism, they made a pact with the devil, with that baptism. As time goes on it will become clearer and clearer, the devil has blinded them they are ignorant to the things of God.

There are thousands of young people they just follow the trend, and Paul had good advise. They don't have to follow down that marriage path because we are living in the end-time. Paul kept saying that it is better to remain single if people would only take his advise they would save themselves a lot of heartaches, because down that marriage path there is a lot of pain, especially for the women. Women have gotten a rough ride in this world since Eve made that choice.

Especially, in some of these countries, like Iran, and such. I read in the news where they are finding these graves and in these graves are girls that they kill because they think that it is a curse to have a girl. When they are born and they see that it is a girl they kill it and bury it. So they are discovering these graves with girls buried there. That is the society that we are living in the devil hates women. Women have had it

rough, but they could have it better because Paul said - I spare you. They could have it like you, you couldn't have it any better.

We are going to go into Winnipeg pick up a trailer and go down to Florida where it is warm. Then we back up to the dock we don't even have to take off the load. I was thinking about that how good we have it then, we can even unhook the truck and go down and walk along the beach or go down to the shopping mall until they are finished with off loading.

I can't think of anything better if you would be on the colony you would have to follow a program, especially being single. That is why Paul said I spare you and that is where our heart is. We are having this conversation just to prove how good we have it, and thousands of people could have it. That is what I wanted for my daughters but apparently, they didn't want it, they were so brainwashed in thinking that you have to go down that marriage path. See, somewhere back in your youth you made that decision I don't want that I just want to live for the Lord, I don't want to go down that marriage path. We are not just having this conversation this is real, we are living it; it is life, you can prove it to them, you don't have to worry about money, everything that I have is yours; everything that we have is the Lord's. If the Lord sees something, He will even give us more than what we actually think that we need.

We thought that we don't really need that new truck, that Ford was just too much of a truck. I know how He works, we were going through Medicine Hat, and there was this guy with a Honda beside us and I ask the guy how he likes it and he said he gets 30 miles to the gallons with it. Then you found out on the internet that it was truck of the year. So we went and bought that Honda, not that we needed it, but you can see how He gives us more than we need. It says, He will give it *good measure, pressed down, and shaken together, and running over*. That is how the Lord supplies all our needs. *But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus. Philippians 2:18.*

We can truly say it because we are experiencing that. The Lord wants to shower His blessings on people, but you have to meet the conditions; pass the test. We passed the test I could have just decided to stay with that artificial security on the colony, but I decided I don't want it, I want this Word, this fellowship around God's Word, that is more to me than life itself. To get together with someone and have a conversation around the Word, and have a perfect understanding of this Word we can go for from Eternity and go into Eternity. I could have never done that had I been content with just living on the colony. You can't even believe in a Millennium without getting excommunicated. My uncle he was excommunicated

because he believed in a millennium. That's how they have you locked in a cage.

Today we can go to Ephesians one, and we understand it, how God that great eternal spirit made that great blueprint. He made a plan back in the eons of ages before there was even a speck of dust, before there was an angel, or a star, before there was anything at all. Just this great vast space. God that eternal spirit; the self-existing one, He counselled with himself and He planned that great blueprint of creation and when He had it all planned out He began His great creation and that blueprint started to come together. It says that He is going to make sure that that blueprint is going to go according to His will and it will be fulfilled right to a T, He predestinated us according to His foreknowledge. In His foreknowledge, He knew that we were going to be trucking together. He did not worry about what people would say, do, or think. He is sovereign unto Himself, He does things and He does not ask what you think, or what I think, He just does it, because He is righteous, and He does things right.

Then why would you have a man rule over you and not Jesus Christ. He is trustworthy. In fact, He is more than trustworthy. To find a word to described how trustworthy He is, He is million times more than trustworthy, He has proven to be that in our lives. Sometimes you get bogged down about your family and stuff, but He will look after that too. You worry

about your children, and you would like to make it easy on them, sometimes they are their own worst enemy. Like Jennifer, she does not even want to read my books, and sends them back. It would help her eternal destiny, but they are not interested, they have been brainwashed in thinking that I am the bad guy, and these preachers are the good guys.

Maybe I will bring it out next week, the Lord has been dealing with me on who the good guy is and who the bad guy is. My family is brainwashed in thinking that I am the bad guy but it is the opposite.

This has been my thought, I thought that I would go about it from a different angle, but really I am saying the same thing. You have to get it into your DNA that Paul meant it well when he wrote that in Corinthians - I spare you. If people could only get that who Paul really was. You can see his heart when he said that in. That is putting yourself on the line. *Romans 9:*

1. I say the truth in Christ, I lie not, my conscience also bearing me witness in the Holy Ghost,

2. That I have great heaviness and continual sorrow in my heart.

3. For I could wish that myself were accursed from Christ for my brethren, my kinsmen according to the flesh:

4. Who are Israelites; to whom pertaineth the adoption, and the glory, and the covenants, and the

giving of the law, and the service of God, and the promises;

5. Whose are the fathers, and of whom as concerning the flesh Christ came, who is over all, God blessed for ever. Amen.

See that is Paul's heart, why would you not trust a man that would for the sake of his people be cut off so that they could be partakers of Christ. That is his desire for every young girl, for every young guy out there - I didn't tell you not to get married. I am not forbidding marriage, if people get married they will want to say that - Sam is forbidding to get married. No, it is advice. Paul didn't forbid marriage, he advised them. He was a man that cared about people, that is what he is really saying if you want to save yourself a lot of heartaches, a lot of sorrow then listen to my advise. Why would you want to be married to this person that you don't even know what they are like. You think you do. Paul is saying get married to Christ. He will never give you a broken heart; He will always meet your needs. He will take you from glory to glory, that is really what our lives have been. When we were done with PTL, He took us over to Payne, I don't know how long we will be there, He will just have something better if there is such a thing.

I have heard a lot of people say that Paul did not know what he was talking about. He knew exactly what he was saying, and it makes perfect sense.

Lorraine speaks: People will never see this chapter if they want to follow their own desires. It's only for people who have a desire to live for the Lord and have a desire to please Him. I analyzed this marriage thing and what Paul said in Corinthians when I was young, and I observed things and I realized that only Jesus Christ could satisfy that hunger in my soul.

My brother asked me one day, we were outside sitting by the fire-place one evening, and he asked me: Lorraine what about you, are you going to get married and all that. I remember telling him: No, I'm just going to follow Jesus and what He has for me. Even in saying, I want to follow Jesus, God will test you to see if you are serious or not he will even put an opportunity before you to see if you are really serious or if its just a half-hearted decision you made. Paul knew what he was talking about. Nothing in this world compares to what Jesus has for you. Paul knew that from experience and he wanted everyone to partake of that glorious intimacy with the Lord Jesus Christ. This song: I come to the garden alone, will be real to you, as He walks with you and He talks with you and He tells you are His own, and the joy is truly like none other than you have ever known.

*I come to the garden alone
While the dew is still on the roses
And the voice I hear falling on my ear
The Son of God discloses.*

*And He walks with me, and He talks with me,
And He tells me I am His own;
And the joy we share as we tarry there,
None other has ever known.*

*He speaks, and the sound of His voice,
Is so sweet the birds hush their singing,
And the melody that He gave to me
Within my heart is ringing.*

*I'd stay in the garden with Him
Though the night around me be falling,
But He bids me go; through the voice of woe
His voice to me is calling.*

It is worth it all, sure there will be times of testing,
and you just have to hold on to what the Lord has
allowed you to see. Mary had that desire like it says in
the German song - *Eins ist not ach Herr dies Eine:*

*Wie Maria war beflissen
auf des Einigen Genieß,
da sie sich zu Jesu Füßen
voller Andacht niederließ;
ihr Herze entbrannte, dies einzig zu hören,
was Jesus, ihr Heiland, sie wollte belehren,
ihr Alles war gänzlich in Jesum versenkt,*

und wurde ihr Alles in Einem geschenkt.

Mary knew what Jesus had for her, and there was nothing that would take it from her. I can say that too, I know what Jesus has done for me and nothing can ever replace that.

Sam speaks: I don't think that I have ever heard anyone say what we are saying here what Paul said here in Corinthians. They all find fault with it, and say, Paul, didn't know what he was talking about. He knew what he was talking about. He was only given certain revelations. Paul didn't use his own intelligence like a lot of preachers do. He had a lot of intelligence, he was brought up at the feet of Gamaliel. He knew a lot but he considered it all as dung, he had to depend solely on revelation to build the church of the living God. *Yea doubtless, and I count all things but loss for the excellency of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord: for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and do count them but dung, that I may win Christ, Philippians 3:8.*

When Paul used his own opinion he said it. Paul meant it well with people. Like 1 Corinthians 7, God had given Paul the revelation of the end-time, because he wanted this to be written that it would be written in the Bible for us, not for those people back there, but for this generation. Then God allowed him to see that it is not for that generation back there, because later he advised the young people to go and get married that it

is not for their hour. God didn't let him see that until it was down in print for us in this generation. Now it is the shortness of time. I have seen it for a long time. I know that you have to have a reverence and respect for the Word of God. God is behind all this, He allowed Paul to say that. It has to all come together, because they would not say back there — he who preaches another gospel let him be accursed. Line upon line. It is built on the apostles and the prophet and Jesus Christ being the chief cornerstone. Whatever you hear today you and I can search it out through that apostolic ministry. If someone comes along even a man like brother Jackson and says that the ministry will see eye to eye, you can't find it in the scripture. You have to go back to the apostle, Jesus Christ being the chief cornerstone. It says, the watchman will see eye to eye.

That is the message for this hour, for this generation: just stay single overcome your desires, this sex for pleasure thing is a delusion there is nothing in it. A moment of pleasure that's all it is.

Heavenly Father we just pray that you will take these words that have been said and use them for your honour and glory, inspire Lord, and most of all give that increase. Give the people the picture what we are trying to say here. I don't have the ability to put things together, but you can give people the picture and allow them to see the desire that Paul had for the Human race and that he wanted to spare them. We ask these things in Jesus Name. Amen.
