

One day I ran into a relative and he suggested that I write a book to tell people what I'm about and where I'm coming from. I thought I'll take this opportunity to let people know that it was my hunger for the things of God that have led me to this path of life. It is open for anyone that has that hunger and that thirst. This is who I am and what I'm about: In HIM we live, move and have our being!

I guess it was last Wednesday night I was up about three, four in the morning. You know there is a lot of things a guy can say, but unless the Lord is in it, then it's just beating your gums together.

I was reminded of an episode that happened back in 1975: The year of the Eclipse. I went back on the internet to find out when that was. It was on May the 8th or the 9th of 1975. We had a man come to our house, we had just moved into a different house because they were tearing our house down. I know that that was the year of the Eclipse. It wasn't at the Eclipse that he was there, but he was there that year because we were in that house for only a year, when he came to our house. He had just recovered from a massive heart attack. We were sitting in the kitchen and he proceeded to tell my dad about his experience he had when he had this massive heart attack. He was dead, I believe, he said for 7 minutes, he was cleaning out an elevator down in Mitchell South Dakota, and from the time he had his heart attack from the time they revived him, I think it was 7 minutes. He proceeded to tell my dad about his experience. What transpired in those 7 minutes, when you die it's only your body that dies your

spirit and soul doesn't die. It just keeps going on so he just found himself in his soul and in his spirit trying to get into the heavenly kingdom, into the pearly gates and they won't let him in. Here is a man all he has ever done was work, every-time you would see him he was working and he was a good Hutterite, the best that I know and here he cannot get in. They ask him, 'why should we let you in?'

'Oh I worked in the Hutterite colony, I did this and that and the other, I did the best I knew to do.'

They asked him, 'what's the Hutterite colony, it's not here?' They asked him, 'what did you do for Jesus?'

You know he couldn't answer and he realized he is doomed. He can't get in and he started pleading with these angels standing before the entrance. Give me another chance. That's what he shared with my dad, his experience and I don't think he was telling a lie, I think he was telling the truth. He was very earnest and very serious, very solemn. The memory I imagine was still burning in his mind and in his soul about what a horror it is not being able to enter in once you die. As I said, I was listening we were sitting in the little kitchen and he told us about his experience. I was there, my dad, this man, and this man's daughter. He couldn't drive cause he lost his license when he had the heart attack so his daughter was driving him around.

He continued to tell about his experience. He just begged and pleaded, 'give me another chance, I'll do whatever it takes', and so they revived him and he came back to life. I guess they put the machines on him where

they give him a shock and he came back. It was about 3 to 4 months he started to recover and that's when he was at my dad's place. I was listening; I was taking it all in and he said to my dad, 'we have to do something this Hutterite way of life is not the way into the kingdom of God, its deception'.

Many people think being in the colony and doing things is the way to heaven and it's not, I have experienced it first hand and he said this to my dad.

'There is something out there somewhere, there is got to be something. If God will see how serious we are, he will show us, there is something somewhere, I know there is. He said, I need 4 people, I need 3 more people besides myself. He said, I'll go south, you'll go west, I'll get Mike from Milltown, he'll go east and I'll get Jake,' (I guess the 4th one was Jake Waldner from New Haven, Clearwater I guess it was at that time, Jake from New Haven I think it was).

He was looking for 4 people that kind of had a spiritual backbone, what you would call somebody that has a little depth and somebody that was pretty outspoken when it came to spiritual matters. So that's what he came up with, these 3 people but, you know he never could get it off the ground. He never could put 3 people together to go on this venture, and 4-5 years later he died without having done that cause he couldn't find anybody that would venture out.

I heard what he said, and I heard the seriousness in his voice and it stayed with me over the years, it just kept

coming back to me from time to time. I'm living in this Hutterite colony, I'm working every day, but at the end of the day, I've got nothing, if I put my trust in that Hutterite colony and think 'gemeinschaft' is going to get me to heaven, it's not going to do it.

Here is a man that had an experience; its like the rich man telling Abraham, send somebody, send Lazarus back and tell my family that this is not the way, they are going down the wrong way, so they don't come to this place of horror and Abraham told him, if they don't believe The Word, Moses and the Prophets they wouldn't believe when somebody comes back from the dead. I experienced that first hand, I went down to talk to his boys from Forest River, this man that came to our house and they didn't seem to want to talk about it. I told them what I heard him say, how desperate he was. Somebody did come back from the dead, God gave him back his life and he came back and he told us, that is not the way to go. Yet people don't want to listen, they kind off wish that he hadn't said it. Trying to shut it up. I heard him say it and it stuck with me over the years for more than 15 years, from time to time, I would think about it.

There is another man that I heard say something similar, the same thing. Mike from Sunnyside (Muma), and here he is dying, I guess he was diagnosed with cancer or something. He tells his boys, 'don't do as I did. All I ever did every day go over in that shop and worked on these trucks and it's all I did all my life. Now I'm dying and I

haven't done a thing for Jesus. All I did was go to work every day and now I'm empty-handed'.

Like the song says ,“Muss ich geh'n mit leeren Handed, so vor meinem Herrn zu steh'n? Kann ich keine Seel' Ihn bringen, keine einzigen Garbe seh'n?”

Here he is dying and he sees the reality of it. See when you live from day to day you don't see the reality of things. It's when you come to die, that's when he saw the reality of the thing. I haven't done anything for Jesus. He warned his boys not to be like he was. That's what I heard, I'm going to have to go and ask them if that is what he said. I think they moved up to Gladstone, but eventually, I'm going to go up and see them and talk to them about this episode. That's what I heard he said, he warned them just before he died; maybe a week before he died.

So these things they stuck with me and back it 1993-94, the church split had already happened, Jake from Blumengart was the 'elder' for the Gibbs faction, and they were just coming up 'zu ihn Elie einsetzen'. When you become a preacher after a few years they will ordain him. I was going back and forth, I was still in the colony but I wasn't part of the colony thing, I was trying to find my way back to the colony but they wanted to put me through ausschloss and I said I'm not going through that because I didn't do a thing all I did was, I couldn't support Jake Kleinsasser anymore. To make a long story short, I knew if I was at home in my house when they come to ordain Elie, those preachers, they are going to go after my wife.

They can't touch me because I'm not part of the clan but I was staying at my house I was working outside. I had a car, I was going to work every day, and I would come home each night. I was sitting, I think it was about February or March, it was kind of a stormy day, drizzly, stormy and snowing. I looked out the window and I said, 'Lord there's got to be something'. I knew that if I'm in that house the next day; like this was on a Saturday around 4 pm. So they start coming in around 5-6. I'm sitting looking out the window and I said, 'Lord there's got to be something somewhere,' I was reminded of that man's voice that had that heart attack and that other guy that was dying now from cancer. These things kept going over and over in my mind and I knew, Lord, there has got to be something somewhere. I'm going to go out to my car, it's about 50 feet; I still had my car, I'm going to get in my car and I'm going to go somewhere. I'm going to drive until I run out of gas, or run out of food, or run out of money but there is got to be something somewhere. I was serious, I just knew there had to be. I knew this Hutterite thing that was not it. I knew it from myself and I knew it from that man that had that heart attack had said so on, and this other man Mike also said so.

I got my bags together, my wife was crying, my children were crying, cause they wanted me to go back and join the system. Go through ausschloss and the rigamarole and become part of their clan again. I knew, if I did I could never live with myself, cause I knew that wasn't it, living a hypocritical, phony lifestyle. Believing something

that I knew isn't real, and at the end of my life I'll end up empty-handed, and I just become another one that hears that voice 'depart from me'.

Anyway, I packed my bags took my stuff out to my car. As I said, my children were crying, I just could not explain to them why, and where I was going cause I didn't know myself where I was going. I just in my heart knew I got to keep going, I can't stop now. So I got my bags out to my car and I was halfway out to my car, and the Lord spoke to me, 'go to Vancouver,' and when he did I saw a building (a church building), so I at least knew where I was going, I was going west. As I said, it was stormy and overcast and a very miserable day, I knew I was going west to Vancouver, that's all the Lord gave me. He didn't say what was out there, He just said, 'go to Vancouver,' and He gave me a vision of a building.

I went up as far as Swift Current, there was a terrible storm, they had the roads closed. I ended up at some kind of a Convention Centre. They had stopped all the traffic, and the people were staying at the Convention Centre. The place was full of all kinds of people. It was Easter break at that time, so people were going on vacation, but the roads were closed so everybody had to stay at this Convention Centre, on a sponge and that's where I spent the night.

Well, the next day they opened the road and I was able to continue on, but I had in my mind, I have to go to Vancouver, and at the same time, the Lord was dealing with me on Water Baptism, by immersion. For about a



year He was dealing with me on Water Baptism. He allowed me to see in His Word, that you cannot mess with the Word of God. He showed me, He took me back to the days of Moses. When Moses for 40 years he spent in Egypt and 40 years he spent tending the sheep. God was preparing him to lead the children of Israel out of Egypt. On the way to Egypt, He was going to kill him because there was some Scripture that he hadn't fulfilled. He had told Abraham, that every child had to be circumcised, and Moses hadn't circumcised his boys. Here he was going over to Egypt to bring the children of Israel out of Egyptian bondage and he hadn't fulfilled the Scripture and God was going to kill him. His wife went and took 2 stones and circumcised them. She was actually the one who stopped him from circumcising them, he would have but she won't let him, that's the way I see it. That's where I saw how serious God is, here He had a man prepared for 80 years and He was going to completely wipe him out because he hadn't fulfilled His Word, what He had told Abraham to do.

All these different Scriptures kept coming to me, I was under terrible conviction about Water Baptism by immersion. I remember driving through Regina and I thought to myself if I saw somebody baptizing by the ditch or by the river, I would go get baptized by immersion. That's all the Lord convicted me off, cause that Mike from Hillside every time I would run into him, he'd ask, 'Sam have you been baptized'. I said, 'ja I was baptized in the colony,' he said, 'that's not a baptism, God will not recognize it, that's not in the Bible,' and every time I would



see him, that's all he would talk about; baptism. You've got to get baptized by immersion. I remember one day I said to him, 'Mike I don't want you to harass me anymore. I'll go get baptized just to get you off my back,' and he never bothered me after I said that.

Now here the Lord was putting me under conviction about this Water Baptism. So I'm driving along, and I ended up going to Joe Waldner, over at Barnwell Alberta. He'd come from Glenway Colony and when I got there, (see when the Lord convicts you about something it consumes you day and night), so when I got there, I said, 'Joe, I need to get baptized, the Lord has been really dealing with me to get baptized by immersion.'

He didn't say anything. The next morning when I got up, I said, 'you know I need to get baptized'. I think it was 3 or 4 times I told him that I need to get baptized somehow. I've got to get someone to baptize me by immersion.

He said to me, 'well we have a tank full of water, down in the building down here, 2 weeks ago the Lord dealt with us to go down and get a tank fill it with water, so we are going to baptize you; it is ready'. See I didn't know that; that the Lord was dealing with him too. Well, anyway they baptized me by immersion in the titles, the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Ghost.

Well, I stayed there I think for 6 weeks or so and then I proceeded to continue on my journey, to go where the Lord told me to go, go to Vancouver. I had worked there because I needed some money, I worked there for maybe

2 months or a little longer. Then one day I got into my car and continued to go out to Vancouver, but I didn't go through Canada, I went down through Billings MT. The last night I stayed overnight at Joe Hofer, I said to Joe when you get up in the morning I'll probably not be here; I'll be gone. At 4 o'clock in the morning, the Lord wakes me up and lets me know its time to go. So I drove down the I-90 down to Washington down to Seattle and I figured I was going to go see my cousin Jake.

All of a sudden at 6 o'clock in the evening I was driving through Seattle up toward Bellingham and I got so tired. I knew I had to go check into a Motel and get some sleep. At that time I was staying at the Comfort Inns, the Lord dealt with me to stay at the Comfort Inns. At 6 o'clock I stopped at the Comfort Inn in Bellingham. I had a good night's rest and that next morning I went down for breakfast and all of a sudden it looked like everybody in the Motel was down for breakfast. The room filled up were they have the Continental Breakfast, and all the tables were full and this man came over and says, 'do you mind if I sit down?' I said, 'yeah,' cause there were no other empty tables and he sat down and we talked a bit.

When I went back to my room, I felt the Lord had put that man there. There was a reason He sent me to that Comfort Inn, there was a reason I got tired; I got sleepy all of a sudden. He wanted me to check into that Comfort Inn, but I didn't know why, so I got on my knees and I asked, 'Lord, why did you sent me here? What's going on?' He

said, 'that man that sat at your table, I want you to talk to him,'

So I called him up, I was in room 106 and he was in 105 because we went back to our rooms together, I said 'I'd like you to come to my room I'd like to talk to you,' and I said, 'I don't know what's going on but I was just down on my knees and the Lord wants me to talk to you, and I don't even know what He wants me to talk to you about.'

He said, 'well I'm a Christian, I got 3 children, I live in Seattle and I'm out here on business.' He was working for some kind of a wire company selling wire to Hydro. He proceeded to talk and then he asked me, he said, 'Sam where is the prophet? I know, he says, we are living in the end time, and when I read my Bible there is a Prophet supposed to show up. Where is he?'

I said, 'I never heard of such a thing; that there is a Prophet, Jesus was the last Prophet.'

Anyway, we parted ways and I went up, it was a Wednesday, to my cousin Jake, from Graceville, SD. I got there about 2 o'clock in the afternoon, and around 5 o'clock, (he was kind of a slow talker very solemn), he said, 'Sam, we are going up to church, up to Vancouver British Columbia to church, you can stay here if you want or you can come, you are welcome to come with us.'

'Oh, I said, I'll definitely come to church.' We went up to the church and when I drove into that parking lot there was that building that I saw, about 3 or 4 months ago when I walked out of that house. That building when the Lord told me to go to Vancouver. When I drove into that

parking lot, there was that same building I saw; I knew it, I recognized it. I went to church and I liked what I saw. I saw people dressed very modest, the women all wore dresses, they all had long hair. The song service was very inspiring, everything, oh man, it was really alive and then the preacher came. I didn't know what this is all about, the Lord is going to show me something here. We went back to Jake's place after church and a whole bunch of ex-Hutterites came over. I think there were about 50 ex-Hutterites up there. They told me about a message, a Prophet and they kept telling me about a Message. They told me about Water Baptism and asked me, 'have you been baptized?' I said, 'Yes, I got baptized here about 3 or 4 months ago.' They asked, 'well how did you get baptized.'

'Oh, I got baptized in a tank, in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Ghost,' and they said, 'well that's not scripture, you are going to have to get re-baptized, in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ.'

Well, they kept on talking, there were about 5 or 6, like they were just giving me this whole thing, like a Message, a Messenger, serpent seed, Baptism in Jesus Name, and a Prophet, and all of a sudden I said, 'listen this is a bloody cult. I don't believe a word you are saying but I'll tell you what I'll do, I see you are all respectable-looking people, I got a lot of respect for you, cause you are dressed well, you carry yourself well. What I'll do about it, I'll pray about it, if the Lord shows me what you are saying here is the truth, I'll believe it.'

They said, 'that's the way to do it, cause if we talk you into it, somebody will come along and talk you out of it, the Lord has to show it to you.'

I just simply asked the Lord, 'what's going on here, is this true?' The Lord spoke to me; He spoke to me in an audible voice.

'This is my Prophet if you believe it, you will be blessed, if you don't believe it, it is still my Prophet.'

I chose to believe it, and He reminded me of that man I saw at that Comfort Inn, just 3 days prior to this or 2 days. Remember that man He said, I put him there to sit at your table, to prepare you the Prophet that was sent to this age. All this is supernatural like I had nothing to do with this, I was just following that voice, that said go to Vancouver, but in the process, I ended up at the Comfort Inn, the man sits at my table, and he asks me, where is that Prophet? I go to my cousin Jake, he takes me to church and I see the building, that I saw in that vision when I walked from my house to my car and then after the church they come and they tell me about a Prophet and about a Message and a Messenger and I realized, that's what that Joe Maendel from Forest River Colony, that boss that had that massive heart attack, that's what he was looking for. I found what he was looking for, there is a Message, here in this end time, and if he would have ventured out as I did, and if he would have done whatever it takes. There's got to be something somewhere, God would have shown him, cause his nephews from Rosedale Colony, that old preacher, Mike's sons they are all out

there in that church, believing that Message, that God sent a Prophet, if he would have kind of just ventured out a bit, God would have shown it to him, but he was looking for 3 other people. But I guess, it was not meant for him cause he was already up in age, God did not mean for him to venture out, I can look back now and I can see it. I heard him say these words, and God required it from me, not from my dad, my dad didn't go on his rendezvous, neither did Mike from Milltown, and neither did Jake from New Haven. He had this little experience and I'm sitting in that little kitchen, and I'm hearing all that and when I look back it was for my ears. I heard him and I did exactly that, I went from my house to my car, put my life on the line.

There is a Scripture, I was actually going to read, "He that will keep his life shall lose it, and he that will lose his life for my sake and the Gospel, he shall gain it for Eternity."

I lost my life when I ventured out, and I lost everything I lost my family, I lost my job, and I lost everything that I ever stood for in that Hutterite colony. I became a vagabond overnight just because I was willing to lose my life, for the sake of Christ and His Word. Just overnight by a snap of a finger, you lost it all and not because I wanted a good time, and not because I'm out there looking for something to do or giving the Hutterites a rough time. There was something inside me burning, I could still hear that man, his desperation after he had recovered from the heart attack. He said, 'John there is got to be something



out there somewhere if God will see how serious we are He will show us, there has to be.'

I heard him say these words, they were ringing in my ear for 15 years. I think it was in 1975, and I think I went out there in 1993-4, somewhere around there. For 15 years that voice was ringing in my ears, I went out there; I realized the man had a Message, God sent a Prophet, and I believed what he said, he taught me about Serpent Seed, what happened in the garden, 2 weeks later I got baptized in the Name of the Lord Jesus Christ, just like the Bible says, Acts 2: 38. All they know 'oh he got baptized 10 times already.' No, I only got baptized once, there is only one baptism, there are not 2 baptisms. There is one God, one Faith, and there is one Baptism. That's another one of the Scripture the Lord convicted me off, there aren't 100 Faiths. There are no 100 ways to get baptized, there is only one!

That's why we sing the song, *"This road is straight and narrow, that the saints have traveled on, paved with all the tribulation, of the martyrs that have gone."* If you are going to go down that way you are going to get persecuted, there is no other way, people think just living on the colony, they are going to go to heaven, but that's not the way it is, you are going to be persecuted. There is a narrow road, it's hard to find that road but by God's grace after I put my life on the line; I lost everything became a vagabond overnight, I found that Road; I found that Message; I found that channel that God has in this

end time. He sent a Prophet, William Marrion Branham, in 1965 he died.

I was just like a kid in a sandbox. Just enjoying everything I heard, and reading the books and the tapes. The book of Revelation all of a sudden opened up to me. See Brother Branham was the only person that God qualified to open up the book the Revelation. If you do not know Brother Branham's message you will never understand the book of Revelation; it's a love letter to the Bride. I proceeded through The Church Ages, the tapes and the books and I just read them and for weeks that's all I did was listen to tapes. I would drive back and forth from Manitoba to B.C and I had a whole bunch of tapes, I would just listen to tapes all the way back and forth. Then the Lord, once I was in that movement, I was about 3 weeks in the Message and the Lord warned me, " Be very careful, there is a lot of danger in there, in that movement," and he told me the 2 people to watch out for, one of them was, Eddy Biskal; he was the head of that church, out there in Vancouver and another one was Milko Revar. Milko, I would say he is a spy, like not a real spy but he checks everybody out, you know. He makes sure everyone pays their tithes. He makes sure everyone got a job. Anyway, from these 2 people I watched out, I didn't say anything, I just kept it to myself and as I watched the little things it's all about money. If you wonder, why would the Lord tell me to go to a church where there's danger? Well, they have a Message, they preached that Message and the Lord can

keep you no matter how dangerous. The Lord can keep you and after about 3 years, He moved me out of there.

Then He brought me in contact with Brother Jackson's message. Brother Branham had died in 1965 and this was about 1996 when I left that church out in Vancouver. Then I was on my way back to Manitoba and the Lord took me to the ministry of Brother Jackson.

In Revelation, it says, "In the days of the voice of the 7th angel, when he shall begin to sound, the mystery of God should be finished," and there is a word in there, "begin," it doesn't say, 'in the days of the voice of the 7th angel when he shall sound.' It says, "When he shall begin to sound". You see Brother Branham was not the angel, he was the 'voice of the angel when he shall begin to sound,' and when Brother Branham died in 1965 that angel didn't die. That angel kept speaking but he couldn't speak through Brother Branham's vocal cords anymore, and God showed me; He led me to Brother Jackson's ministry. When I heard Brother Jackson preach, I knew, in my heart, I knew, this is what I have been looking for all my life. When I heard Brother Branham's message inside of me I was still searching for something, I didn't know what it was, I'm searching in my heart I'm searching. It is like, I knew what I was searching for is somewhere in the church but I didn't know what it was. I'm not searching for a good time or a business or something like that. I'm searching for something yet I didn't know what it was.

One day I heard Brother Jackson preach on a videotape. I think he preached "The seventy weeks of

Daniel," I was up in Kelowna B.C and the man that I was staying with said, 'do you mind if we put on a video, hear some preaching,' and I said, 'Sure we can always listen to some preaching'. He put on a video of Brother Jackson, and I said, 'who is this man, that would take the Word of God with precision accuracy and place it exactly where it belongs.' I kept listening and I realized this is what I have been looking for, this is what I've been looking for all my life, and here I find it, the ministry of Raymond M. Jackson.

That was in 1996, Brother Jackson died 2004 and for 10 years I just loved everything that that man said, he opened up the Scriptures to me. There are a lot of things Brother Branham said, 'dual statements,' he said different things but he like the Bible says, 'he will turn us back to the Word. He came to turn us back to the Bible, back to the Apostolic Faith of our Forefathers,' and to do that he would leave dual statements, he would say, 'there are 7 years left for the Jews', and another place he would say, 'there are 3.5 years'; well they can't both be right.

By saying that it caused me to go to the Scripture to find out which one is right, that's his job to turn us back to the Word. If everything he said was right you would not have to go back to the Word and check it out. Brother Jackson came and cleaned up a lot of this; Brother Jackson was the continuation of that angel's voice.

I found what that man, Joe Maendel, when he had this heart attack, when he recovered he wanted to do something, he said, 'there is something somewhere'. I

found that something, I found that pearl of great price, but it cost me everything. Like the Bible says, “ The Kingdom of heaven is likened unto a man that found the pearl of great price,” and he had to sell everything. You’ve got to lose everything to own that pearl. It’s still the same today this thing is not that easy to find. People don’t have to go through what I had to go through, all they’ve got to do is believe what I’m saying and they’ve got it, it’s that simple. The Bible says, “If you believe a prophet, in a prophet’s name, you shall receive a prophet’s reward,” and I believe Brother Branham. I believe the message. I believe he was a prophet of God. I believe it, I don’t have to go through what he went through and you don’t have to go through what I went through, all you have to do is believe what I’m saying to be a truth. Brother Branham was the 7th Church Age Messenger, he was that prophet that the Bible talks about, he was that ‘something’ that, that man wanted to go out looking for, when he said, ‘there is got to be something out there somewhere.’ I found 'that' all you got to do is believe me and you are hooked in; you get the same reward. You don’t have to go and sleep in a Convention Centre, run through a storm and go out to Vancouver and so forth. You don’t have to go through all that, you just believe what I’m saying. God sent a Prophet, in 1965 he died, that continued on with Brother Jackson, in 2004 he died and now God is intimately dealing with us to read His Word go back to His Word and He’ll lead us on, into that glorious Rapture.

There is a rapture coming, there are a lot of things I can say, but I'm just giving you the highlights of how I happened to find what that man couldn't find. He said, 'there is something out there somewhere,' and that's what the Lord was dealing with me the other morning on, here last Thursday morning when I woke up, around 4-5 in the morning. He just brought this thing back to my remembrance and He wanted me to have a conversation about that.

When we were up at Joe Waldner last week, he talked about these Maccabees, and it looked good the way he explained it and everything, it almost looked like I should go check them out, but it's only a distraction. There is only one way, God didn't send 2 Messengers, He sent one Message. He sent a Prophet in this end time and the people that follow that pattern; that stream, are the once that are going to go to that rapture if they continue on. If they give up halfway through the journey and decide you know I'm going to go follow the Maccabees, this club or so on, you are going to lose it. You've got to continue on that stream that God is on. The people that are going to the rapture are going to believe that God sent a Prophet. They are going to get baptized in Jesus' Name. They are going to believe that God sent an Apostle, Brother Raymond M. Jackson. He didn't send 10 apostles. He sent one. The people that are going to go to the finished line are going to believe what that man taught. They are not going to change it; they are not going to say, 'the midnight cry hasn't happened yet'. The midnight cry happened on



February the 28th 1963. I think it was about 11 a.m. when these angels came down and talked to Brother Branham and told him to go back to Jeffersonville and preach the 6 seals. That's when the 'Midnight Cry' was, it's not 'ongoing,' it's not something in the future. It happened on February 28, 1963 and the things that Brother Jackson taught, anyone who changes it, like it says in Revelations, "He that takes away part of this prophecy, his part will be taken out of the book of life, and he that adds to God will add to the plaques."

There are people preaching today that just change things. All of a sudden they will say, 'we are in the 3rd day,' all of a sudden they will say, 'the 2 days are over,' all this junk, it's all just junk. The Lord is allowing it to test you and me, are we going to stay with this Word? Are we going to allow ourselves to be brainwashed? Do we know what you believe, do you know why we believe it? I know what I believe and I know what I heard. I'm not going to say that everything Brother Jackson said, is 100% right, but if I have a question about something I'll find it in the Scripture.

Brother Jackson said, 'the ministry will see eye to eye,' and I believed it until the Lord pointed to that word 'the watchmen'. The watchmen will see eye to eye, an evangelist is not a watchman. If you put an evangelist under pressure, guess what he'll do? He'll cut and run cause he can't take that pressure. It's only the watchman that can take that pressure. The watchmen are going to see eye to eye, only the watchmen.

When Zion is gathered, Isaiah 52:8, “Thy watchmen of that day will see eye to eye,” no evangelist is a watchman, you couldn’t make an evangelist into a watchman even if you tried. He doesn't evolve into a watchman once he is an evangelist. A watchman is the one that has that prophetic gift, a watchman is a prophet that can see of into the distance. Brother Branham was a prophet, he would see things in the future. He is gone now.

There are still people around that have that prophetic gift, they are going to be the once when Zion is gathered that will see ‘eye to eye,’ not the ministry; the ministry is not the watchmen. I saw that one day. Brother Jackson said the ministry will see eye to eye, maybe by that time the watchmen will be the ministry. There is so much chaos right now in the ministry you don’t know whom to believe, one guy says this, one guy says that and it’s all to test you and me, are we going to stay with this Word? I have no problem, I see exactly; I know what I believe, I know what I was taught, I’m not taking anything away from that Word of Prophecy. That Word of Prophecy says, “The watchmen will see eye to eye”. That is what the Bible says and at ‘midnight there was a cry,’ the midnight happened in 1963. It's not something that will happen in the future like some have tried to tell us. The 2 days of Hosea 6:2, they are not done yet, the grace age is still on, Brother Jackson taught us when the 2 days are done and it is when the 7 years of Daniel starts. They are trying to tell us the 2 days are done, well we are not in the week yet. How can the 2 days

be done! Where are we then? Another guy tries to tell us we are in the 3rd day, well the 3rd day is the millennium, we can't be in the 3rd day. Brother Allen, a guy that stood beside Brother Jackson all these years, he comes out with a teaching we are in the 3rd day, it's hocus-pocus, a bunch of junk, but it's there to test you and me, where do we stand.

We've got to know what we believe, we've got to know that Word. I know what I was taught, I know what Brother Branham said, I know what Brother Jackson said. I listened to his tapes, I listened to them all week long as I was driving to and from work. I would tape the message on Sunday and all week long I would listen to it over and over again until I knew exactly what they were saying. It has helped me to this day, nobody is going to change my mind on these things. I know what I heard, I know what he said, he said after the 2 days (2000 years) the week of Daniel starts, not a year later, no it's in that mili-second.

Like back when the Jews were cut off, some say the Jews were cut off in 56 AD. No, the Jews were cut off at the crucifixion when that curtain tore in the temple. When that earthquake was and the temple curtain tore, prior when that curtain was still in tack they were still under the law. Once that curtain tore Grace was on, not just for the Jews but for the Gentiles. A split second separates the Law age from the Grace age. Not a week, not a month, not ten years, but a split second a millisecond, you can't even count, just a blink of an eye separates the two: One-second you are in the Law Age the next second you are in

the Grace Age. That's what I believe and nobody is going to change that. I know what I heard, I know what I see, and I know what makes sense, it has to make sense.

So these are the things we will have to know, what we believe, where we stand, and all people will have to do is just believe what I'm saying, I know I'm right. I heard that man say that there is something out there. I know the Lord led me to the message of Brother Branham and after I was done, He led me to Brother Jackson. I know what Brother Jackson said and now these so-called perverters they are trying to change everything, make me believe a lie. I don't believe that junk. I can't even listen to them anymore, it's a waste of time. I would rather listen to a frog croak than listen to some of that stuff that's being taught out there. I rather listen to the birds early in the morning, hear them sing than to listen to something like that.

That's where I stand and believe. Brother Jackson said over and over, know what you believe and know why you believe it. You have got to have Scripture otherwise, it's just hypothetical, if you don't have Scripture to make you solid then someone can just come along and they can just tell you anything: looks good, sounds good but when you analyze it, it doesn't make sense. How can you be in the 3rd day? How can you be after the 2 days? We have got to be somewhere.

I remember you saying, 'where are we if we aren't in the 2 days did we fall off a cliff?' That's basically what you have to do, you are nowhere if you believe the 2 days are done. You've got no record of nothing. You are nowhere

and people believe it, grown men that have been preaching for years they believe it. Oh, it sounds good, it looks good. A very respectable man said it. You have got to know what you believe in this hour cause there are all kinds of spirits out there, deceiving and being deceived.

That's the stream that that man would have found if he would have pursued it. He would have found the same thing I found, and it's the ministry of Brother Branham and it went on to Brother Jackson, and now it's up to each and everyone to have a hunger in your heart to continue on. If they have that hunger they will end up where we are at. I remember some time ago you told me how you came across this message, can you say it in your own words how you came across it.

Lorraine talks "It was probably around 2000, I was reading my Bible and I was reading Malachi 4:5, and it says. "Behold I will send Elijah the Prophet before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the Lord and he shall turn the heart of the father to the children and the heart of the children to their father, lest I come and smite the earth with a curse," I remembered I was so excited I went and told my mom and my dad, I was still on the colony there. I told them that the spirit of Elijah will come again before Jesus comes or returns. They just looked at me funny and said, 'Ja, he did come with John the Baptist'. I said, 'no', it says, before the dreadful day of the Lord; before He returns', and they just looked at me strangely. I always kept that in my heart, that Scripture, and it wasn't until about 5 years later that I was given me

the book: The Seven Church Ages, by Brother Branham, I read it and I realized that this is the Prophet that Malachi talks about, I believed it and the Lord led me on, and I was introduced to the ministry of Brother Jackson.”

Sam talks, That’s just the way it goes the Bible says, *“The wind bloweth where it listeth, you hear him but you don’t know where he is coming from and you don’t know where he is going, so is everyone that is born out of the spirit of God.”*

With me He dealt completely different, I had to go through every nook and cranny that’s out there. Finally, I came to the Message and 10 years later we met up and that’s the way it’s going to be, everyone that has a hunger and a thirst is going to find it. This is that stream; that channel that’ll lead us on to eternal life, to that glorious Rapture. I knew this was it and nobody is going to change my mind on it, though many have tried already to throw me a curveball, I know what I believe, I know what I see and nothing is going to change it. I’m just moving on its God’s mercy and His grace and that’s just what leads us on is His Grace and Mercy. I thank God for that.

I believe this is the last generation, before the Lord sets up His Kingdom, for 1000 years. There are people living now that will not die that will go to the marriage supper of the Lamb. *“Blessed are they which are called unto the marriage supper the of Lamb.” Revelation 19:9.*

There are certain conditions you will have to believe and meet.



#1. God sent a prophet to this age, Malachi 4: 4-5, Brother William Marrion Branham, and continued with an Apostle Brother Raymond Jackson

#2. You must be Baptized in the Name of the Lord Jesus Christ, Act 2:38

I believe this to be a truth and I am not ashamed of it. I will not be intimidated by what people think, say, or do. God Bless each and everyone that believes this and takes it to heart.
